

Hotels in Annapolis in summary: Very few hotels are located downtown with the exception of the Marriott, O'Callaghan's, and Loew's and these are pricey. The lower priced hotels are near the mall, with a short drive. There are quite a few B&Bs in Eastport and walking distance to SSA and downtown.

- Book early as July is high-season.
- If you know for sure you want the room and won't need to cancel, you can get better rates on [www.Travelocity.com](http://www.Travelocity.com) (requires pre-payment/non-refundable).
- Annapolis Tourism has the full list of hotels and B&Bs available in Annapolis [www.VisitAnnapolis.org](http://www.VisitAnnapolis.org). Click on 'Sleep'
- We have a block of rooms available at the Country Inn & Suites Annapolis ([http://www.countryinns.com/annapolismd\\_west](http://www.countryinns.com/annapolismd_west)). You must make reservations before June 22<sup>nd</sup>. (Say you are with the 'Lightning ACCs')  
The rooms available are:
  - King Suite for \$129/night + tax. The 'king-suite' has a lot of room: a king bed in a bedroom, separate from the sitting room with a pullout couch. This could easily accommodate a husband/wife team plus their third; or enough room for an inflatable mattress for the third.
  - Standard room \$119/night + tax. The 'standard room' has two queen beds. Included: continental breakfast which has one meat/egg entrée every day, waffles, juices, cold cereals, etc. High-Speed Wi-Fi. Indoor pool.
