Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When does registration open?

A: SSA Member registration opens on January 9th and Junior Club Membership registration opens on January 23rd.

Q: What if I'm not a member? How do I sign up?

A: You can sign your sailor up for a Junior Club Membership for \$49 which allows them to participate in Junior programs. Click the "Sign Up" button on our website.

Q: Do I need to send my sailor with a lunch?

A: You will need to send your full-day sailor with a lunch and any part-time sailor with snacks. All sailors need to bring their own reusable water bottle.

Q: What does my sailor need to bring to class each day?

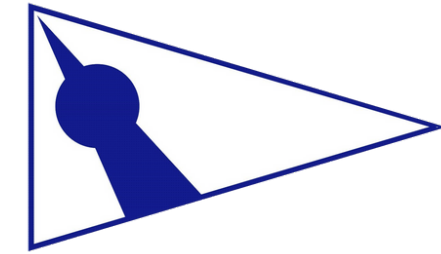
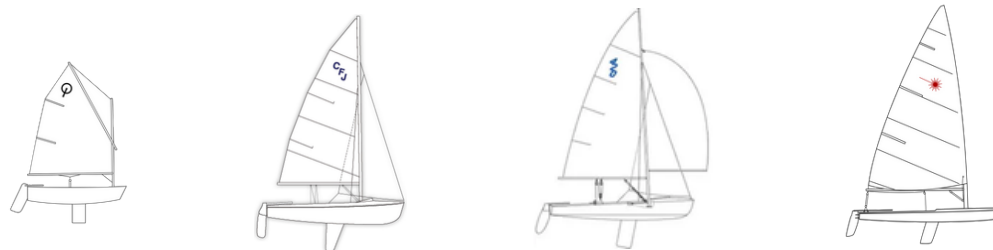
A: Sailors should bring a USCG-Approved Type III PFD with a whistle, closed-toe shoes that can get wet, a towel & change of clothes, sunscreen, sunglasses, a hat, lunch/snacks, a reusable water bottle, and in some cases a notebook and pen.
